Superior Civilian Service Award Presented to Mr. Thomas P. Hafer

On July 6, 2005, LtGen. Robert Magnus, Deputy Commandant, Programs and Resources, hosted an award ceremony in honor of Mr. Thomas P. Hafer. On behalf of the Commandant of the Marine Corps, Mr. Hafer was presented the Superior Civilian Service Award by LtGen. Magnus.
